Micro-credential Certificate: 10- Hour Teaching English Online to Groups

Course Description — This is a reading and discussion-based course on effective, current methodology for teaching English online to speakers of other languages with emphasis given to working with students from countries where English is not the dominant language —an English as a foreign language context. While the emphasis is on practical activities and their application, other aspects of English language teaching, such as applicable theories in linguistics and education in the online classroom, will also be addressed.

This course is designed for current online teachers who are transitioning from teaching one-on-one classes to group classes or online teachers working with groups of students looking for new skills and techniques. Most current online teachers have experience teaching one-on-one classes online, but the industry seems to be trending towards schools catering for group classes. While sound teaching practices apply to both one-on-one classes and small groups, online classroom management techniques significantly differ. Teachers who can demonstrate that they can effectively teach group classes online will have an advantage when it comes to landing a job or attracting students to their own school. They will also be much more effective teachers in an online group class setting.
